ECO is a county-wide collaborative of law enforcement & our community partners to assist with Substance Use Disorders, Alcohol Use Disorders, and Mental Health matters. We also work closely with youth and veteran services for a more specific follow-up.

ECO assists are partners to provide outreach with our Recovery Coaches that have lived experience (ideally within 72 hours post incident) to discuss options with the individual and/or family members.

You can call or email to be connected with a Recovery Coach (see bios on ECO website). We also assist with sober living scholarships and transportation to treatment, court, and relevant doctor's appointment.
